



**Extract – AVVRG Standard Operating Procedures:**

## **Code of Ethics**

Ethical requirements of all members of AVVRG are as follows:

- a) Respect the customs and beliefs of all peoples they encounter and not attempt to enforce religious beliefs on any individuals or groups.
- b) Accept the rights of individuals to hold a different point of view.
- c) Provide appropriate assistance to the best of their ability as a volunteer, without restriction, in regard of race, religion, politics, and social status.
- d) Maintain at all times the highest standard of professionalism.
- e) Recognize the extent and limitations of their professional abilities and expertise and not go beyond those boundaries.
- f) Ensure work is based on the need of the community in which they are working.
- g) Support and promote the fundamental principles of the organization.
- h) Refer to a senior member of the AVVRG any problem that is beyond their capacity to resolve.
- i) Not disclose inappropriately any personal information entrusted to them.
- j) Be familiar with the standard operating procedures and governance of AVVRG and abide by them at all times.
- k) Act in a way that maintains, or enhances, the standing of the organization within the community.
- l) Be aware that behaviour considered unacceptable or damaging to the name or welfare of AVVRG, may result in a motion of censure by the AVVRG Management Committee and other action as deemed appropriate.
